



Your child will be tested for SARS-Covid19 prior to their surgery. Here is what you need to know:

- Present yourself with your child to the S1 test center 24 hours prior to the scheduled OR date.
- You must arrive on foot to the test area, which is open from 8am.
- Have your child's Medicare and hospital card in hand.
- No appointment time is necessary but please arrive as early as possible for the COVID-19 test.
- Please identify any special medical condition that could affect testing.
- Following testing, it is advised to self-isolate until the surgery.
- If your child requires other pre-op testing on the same day (for example: blood test, ECG, etc.), please undergo all other tests first before finishing with the COVID test, on your way out of the hospital.
- Testing is a requirement for surgery; if you refuse to have your child tested, no surgery will be performed.

### **Directions to the test center**

#### **From outside the Glen site**

**Arriving by car:** Park in the underground garage and follow directions to S1 Level. The test center is located just beyond the entrance to the Royal Victoria Hospital along the Emergency bay.

**Arriving by foot:** Follow the street ramp down into Emergency and continue walking until the end of the bay, and the triage area is located just beyond the entrance to the Royal Victoria Hospital.

**Arriving by metro:** Follow the signs to the hospital and once you are in the Emergency bay, turn left and walk just beyond the Royal Victoria Hospital doors to the triage area.

#### **From inside the Glen**

Take the elevator to the S1 Level and exit toward Emergency. Continue walking straight to the end of the Emergency bay, just beyond the entrance to the Royal Victoria Hospital.
